

Business Cognate

Students may elect to complete an **optional** Business Cognate in addition to the requirements for the bachelor's degree. This may be met by completing four of the following courses (12 credits):

- ACC 230 Survey of Accounting Concepts
(may substitute ACC 201 and ACC 202 for ACC 230; counts as 3 of the 12 credits/1 of the 4 courses)
- FI 320 Introduction to Finance
- GBL 323 Introduction to Business Law
- MGT 325 Management Skills and Processes
- MKT 327 Introduction to Marketing

The above business courses will count as elective credits for Economics majors.

The Business Cognate will not appear on an official University transcript or diploma. It should be pursued for its educational value as it relates to a student's future academic or professional plans.
